Imbalance towards Discovery:

- Free flowing
- Open-ended
- No frame
- Only group-generated questions
- Doesn't "arrive" at a conclusion
- Minimal leadership
- Undermines clarity and understanding
- Application is limited or disconnected



Imbalance towards Clarity:

- Controlled
- Didactic
- Heavy frame
- Primarily Socratic questions
- Leader determines conclusion
- Mini-lectures
- Undermines true discovery
- Lack of Spirit's work in the community and process



Integration of Discovery and Clarity

- Dynamic
- High participation and ownership
- Questions from both group and leader
- Discussion centers around and is limited by the text
- Skilled leadership
- Enhancing frame
- Teacher as leader, participant, and learner
- Partnership between Holy Spirit, leader, and group
- Summary reflects group's experience
- Core message clear and memorable (i.e., feel impact of the narrative, not just analyze it)
- Genuine conviction leading to transformation
